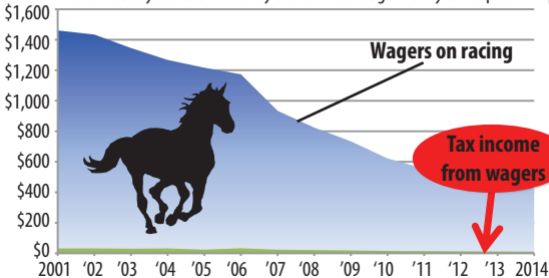


# PA. HORSE RACING: ARE ALL BETS OFF?
