The inn also has free-range hens on property, so if you are interested you can go out in the morning and collect your own organic eggs


to be prepared by the resident chef.

The French Manor Inn and Spa, a dreamy retreat located in the Central Poconos region is the destination for you if you're looking for a weekend filled with luxurious accommodations. This boutique inn and spa retreat is tucked away atop Huckleberry Mountain and is minutes away from all the wonderful amenities the Poconos has to offer. The French Manor has been a AAA Four Diamond recipient numerous times for its restaurant and accommodations.

Modeled after a French Chateau in South France, architectural details make The French Manor Inn and Spa truly unique. A 40-foot vaulted dining room with fireplaces on adjacent walls offers an inviting meeting place for dinners and gatherings. The room opens to a stone veranda which offers a 20-mile view of the Northern Pocono Mountains.

History

During the 1930s the French Manor was built as a "summer retreat" for mining magnate Joseph Hirshhorn. The property was eventually sold to Samuel H. Kress, a successful merchant and owner of S.H. Kress & Co. Variety stores. An avid Italian art collector, Kress represented American opportunity and held the virtues of discipline and hard work close to his heart.

When Kress passed away, his wife gave the manor and its grounds to Bucknell University. The property was eventually bought by Dan and Carolyn Balish who opened it as a bed and breakfast in 1984. In 1990, the property was sold to Ron and Mary Kay Logan, owners and operators of the Sterling Inn.

From there, the Logans transformed the French Manor into a full service romantic inn. The Carriage House was remodeled into a

guesthouse and the La Maisonneuve building was constructed. Inside, are six suites each with a fireplace, jacuzzi and a private balcony.

Bridget and Genevieve, daughters of Ron and Mary Kay Logan, have been running the French Manor together for the past few years.

Rooms

The French Manor Inn offers 19 unique rooms/suites with 6 different styles – choose between luxury spa suites in the La Maisonneuve or authentic castle-esque rooms, decorated with beauty and elegance in mind.

Bed and Breakfast Guest Etiquette

Americans are now embracing what Europeans have known all along: The comforts of bed and breakfast inns often outweigh those in a hotel. Most of them offer not only a relaxing place to sleep but an experience that enables you to have a taste of the area.

Charm

Many travelers have discovered the charm and warmth of most bed and breakfast type inns, so they have gained in popularity over the past couple of decades.

While staying in a B&B is similar to being in a hotel, there are some additional etiquette rules you should know and follow.

Innkeepers

Remember that many people who run this type of establishment generally live there, so treat it with respect as you would anyone's home. The furniture, glasses, towels, and other items belong to them, so never remove these items from the premises; taking them would be stealing. You are a guest in someone's home, so show respect for the hosts.

Return Visits

If you treat the establishment and the hosts with the respect they deserve, they'll welcome you back and may even give you preferential treatment when you call to reserve a room. You don't want to annoy them or have them dread seeing you return.

Bed and Breakfast Etiquette Rules

When you stay at a bed and breakfast, the first thing you need to do is find out if they have any special rules at that particular establishment.

Here are some standard guidelines that you will find at most places:

Don't expect to check in before the listed time unless you have made prior arrangements. When it is time to check out, make sure you have removed all your belongings from the room. The innkeeper needs to change the sheets and get the room ready for the next guest. Many B&Bs stay booked, and you should never infringe on someone else's time. Ask about house rules and follow them. The

rules were established for a reason. If you have an issue with them, discuss your concerns with the owner. You might learn the reason the rule was made.

Don't make noise while others may be sleeping. Keep your voices down in the early morning hours and late at night. During the day, talk in soft tones.

If you have children with you, make sure they behave and follow all the rules. Don't allow them to run down the halls, jump on furniture, or bother other guests.

Show up for meals and other planned activities on time and dressed appropriately. Don't go to breakfast still wearing your pajamas.

Don't take more than your share of the food or drinks during meals or tea. Make sure there is plenty for other guests. After everyone has been served, you may ask for more if you can see that there is enough left.

Feel free to ask the innkeeper questions about the area, but don't monopolize his or her time. There may be other guests who need attention.

Be as neat as possible in the bathroom. Whether it is private or shared with other guests, you don't want to gross out anyone who enters after you leave. If you are sharing a bathroom with other guests, don't dawdle.

Never smoke in the bed and breakfast unless you ask permission first, even in the rooms. You may think you can get away with it without the innkeeper's knowledge, but they will find out. Telltale signs of smoking such as smells, ashes, or discarded cigarette butts may have the host asking you to leave.

Be polite to other guests, even if you disagree with something they say. Don't crowd others or invade their personal space.

At the end of the stay, leave a tip with a short thank you note letting the innkeeper know what you liked about your visit. If you are feeling generous, send a small thank you gift after you return home.

Leave a review for future B&B customers. Make sure you provide details, such as any extra things the innkeeper does to make your stay a pleasant experience.

Always exhibit good everyday manners. Everyone will have a much nicer time if proper etiquette is followed.

The Hillard House Inn, a well preserved Second Empire Mansion, built circa 1865 is minutes away from Wilkes University and King's College and all of the shopping and dining that downtown Wilkes-Barre has to offer.

Owned and operated by Cecilia and Gordon Williams, the couple decided to open a bed and breakfast of their own after staying at one in Rhode Island. The innkeeper, "Mr. Lang," made them feel at home and that feeling was something Cecilia felt like she could take on.

"He (Mr. Lang) went back into the kitchen and I said to Gordy 'we could do this,'" Cecilia says.

"Originally, we thought about doing it part-time, but it turned into a full-time thing," Gordon said while reflecting on his and Cecilia's visit to the Rhode Island bed and breakfast.

The Williams' bought the Hillard House in 1999 and their children went to area grade/high schools.

"My husband loved this house," Cecilia says. "We bought it, moved in, and lived here for a number of years."

Cecilia and Gordon have kept most of the home's original charm, including a 1935 luggage elevator with all of its original equipment (and it still works).

Married for 45 years and traditional bed and breakfast owners for the past 10, the Williams' say out of the thousands of guests they've had, "there's nobody that we wouldn't take back."

"Our first apartment was on Ross Street (Wilkes-Barre), a third-floor walkup," Cecilia says. "Forty years later we're half a

block away in another 3rd floor walkup."

"Except this time, we have an elevator," Gordon laughs. "You never know where life is going to take you."

Rooms

The Hillard House has four unique rooms all with bathrooms. Each room has a refrigerator for drinks and snacks, DirectTV, hair-dryer, guest-controlled air conditioning and heat. Rates include a full gourmet breakfast, off street parking and secure Wi-Fi.

Breakfast

Served between 8 and 10 a.m., Cecilia and Gordon serve a gourmet breakfast under a crystal chandelier in their dining room.

Breakfasts feature homemade muffins, fresh fruit and an entree. Hot coffee, tea and juice is available as well.

Of course, if there are any dietary restrictions or allergies please call ahead of time.

Details


The original owners of the house, The Hillards, occupied the home until the 1950s.





Explore a nearby winery or vineyard

Those who enjoy sipping from a bottle of red, white or blush wine but find that a trip to the Bordeaux region of France simply isn't in the cards right now needn't give up their desires to visit a winery or vineyard. Wineries and fully functioning vineyards dot the landscape of North America. In fact, wine aficionados may be surprised to learn of a winery or vineyard is just a short drive from home.

The American Winery Guide offers that visitors can find a winery and tasting room in just about every state. Colorado boasts 107, Texas has 296, and even Rhode Island, the smallest state, is home to five wineries.

If the goal is to travel to northern regions of North America, Alaska has four wineries, and areas of Nova Scotia, British Columbia, Ontario, and Québec have famed wineries for Canadian oenophiles.

Visiting a local winery or vineyard can be educational and fun. Wine tours can be entertaining because some allow visitors to choose their own tasting adven-

ture depending on their level of interest in wine, their budget and what they would like to get out of the experience. Some wineries and vineyards offer extensive tours of the harvesting and production aspects of wine-making. Others will give visitors a chance to mingle among wine barrels and witness the fermentation process. Still, some wineries or vineyards may limit visitors to tasting rooms where they can sample select vintages.

In regions such as Napa Valley where there are many wineries and vineyards in close proximity to one another, guided tours may be available, or wine aficionados

can explore areas on their own.

Thanks to the diverse North American climate, the types of grape varieties available in one state or province to the next will be quite different. For example, vineyards that thrive in New Jersey are subject to similar climates to those in many areas of France and Germany. As a result, it's not uncommon to find varieties like Cabernet, Chardonnay, Riesling, and Pinot Noir available at facilities in New Jersey.

According to viticulture experts from Professional Friends of Wine, grapevines are fairly adaptable plants that can thrive in a variety of soil types and

temperatures. Soil, sun exposure, drainage, and topography all play roles in how the grapes will ripen and taste.

The chance to support a local business is another reason to make a trip to a nearby winery or vineyard. These facilities often produce wine and sell it close to home. By supporting small business, consumers can contribute to the success and the diversity of offerings where they live.

Wine tastings are an enjoyable recreational pursuit. Remember to drink responsibly, and join the mailing lists of nearby wineries and vineyards to learn more about tasting events and food pairings.

If you're a Wilkes-Barre resident, chances are you've heard of the Stegmaier brewing company. The Stegmaier legacy lives on in downtown Wilkes-Barre in the form of the Frederick and Mary Stegmaier mansions.

In 2001, Joseph Matteo acquired the Frederick Stegmaier Mansion and has worked tirelessly to restore the building to its former beauty. When you walk through the main doors of the Frederick it's hard to not let your imagination wander.

I felt like I was stepping into a time machine as I walked through the high Victorian style rooms.

The Frederick is designed as a bed and breakfast or for smaller, more intimate occasions like private parties or small weddings.

The bed and breakfast has 4 lavishly decorated rooms (3 rooms and 1 suite). Each room is as elegant as the next with comfortable seating areas, detailed wallpaper and era specific art work.

Each room has a private bathroom with toiletries, hairdryer, linens and robes. A complimentary continental breakfast can be served in your room or suite. Also, a writing desk telephone, cable television, DVD player and wireless internet. A gourmet breakfast is also served in the formal dining room.

Joe Matteo offers overnight stays at the Frederick Stegmaier Mansion, but extended stay capabilities are available as well (check the website or call for more information).

The Mary Stegmaier mansion, also located on South Franklin street in downtown Wilkes-Barre, is the destination for large weddings, dinner or cocktail parties.

Art nouveau themed, the Mary Stegmaier mansion is just as

elegant as the Frederick, but in its own way.

One of the most unique features in this mansion (and my personal favorite) was the Solarium room.

Through the sitting area, past the built-in book cases and stained-glass windows, a common theme in the mansion, you will surely be blown away by the bright and airy Solarium room. I visited the mansion on a dreary day and the natural light still seemed to find its way through.

Owning and operating the Stegmaier mansions has been a labor of love for Matteo, but the pride of ownership is so apparent when you walk through any of the mansions' doors.

Matteo says that owning a bed and breakfast isn't for the faint of heart and it's something that isn't ever complete.

His hard work and dedication to the history and integrity of the buildings shows in every square inch of the Stegmaier mansions.

"I don't own the houses," Matteo jokes. "They own me."



Jim Thorpe has been a personal favorite day-trip location for as long as I can remember. With its unique shops, restaurants and endless amount of history – it’s no surprise that The Parsonage a quaint, but quirky art lover’s dream, became what felt like a home away from home after one stay.

The Parsonage Bed and Breakfast is owned and operated by Jeffri Coleman and Michael Rivkin who met in the late 70s at culinary school. They’ve been together ever since, traveling the world and living their best life, eventually finding their place in Jim Thorpe with their sweet rescue pup Pearl.

The Parsonage has been open since April 2016 only nine days after Coleman and Rivkin moved in. Each room is tastefully decorated with artwork and treasures that Jeffri and Michael have collected along their world travels.

Rooms

The Parsonage has four unique rooms, each with a king or queen-sized bed and a private bathroom. Each room has a unique name (every door has a name plate and decor/art style).

William’s room is adorned with botanical and bird print art and décor, every piece of art in this room (and the whole home) was beautiful.

“Each piece has a story,” Michael told me as he gave me a tour through The Parsonage.

Breakfast

Fresh and local ingredients are prepared daily by Jeffri and Michael. Free range eggs, locally sourced meats are available, and mimosas are made (fresh) on Sunday. Any dietary restrictions should be mentioned before checking in so Jeffri and Michael can plan accordingly.

Details:

The Parsonage Bed and Breakfast is the oldest, complete and unchanged home existing from the early history of Mauch Chunk.

It was built as a Parsonage by Reverend Richard Webster, pastor of the Presbyterian Church in the 1800s.

The Inn at Hickory Run, designed and built by owners David and Nancy Pfeil, is a 9,600-square-foot/state-of-the-art bed and breakfast. The Inn is environmentally friendly – designed and constructed with state of the art ‘green’ systems.

A country-style inn, with a rustic and relaxed atmosphere (inside and out) the Inn at Hickory Run truly caters to the people who love the outdoors.

Each room at the Inn was designed based upon the various hardwoods that can be found around the property: maple, birch, oak and cherry. David’s father was a physician and a wood-worker, who would occasionally accept payments for his services with wood. Much of the décor at the Inn at Hickory Run was handmade by David and/or his father.

Accommodations

Every guest room includes a

king or queen sized bed, cable television, DVD player, a premium sound system, fireplace, ceiling fan, wireless internet, two person premium (quiet) whirlpool tub.

Details

David and Nancy Pfeil are both engineering graduates of Lehigh University.

“She’s chemical, I’m mechanical,” David says.

In the past, David owned his own software company and completed a number of impressive projects. This is his third attempt at retirement.

“It really is a difference,” David says. “I probably will live longer

since I’m not doing another software company, so that’s a positive.”

This is the third home the Pfeils have designed and it’s the first bed and breakfast. The property was built from the ground up as a bed and breakfast – with large bedrooms, an extra dining room (one for guests and one for private/family use) and much more.

In 2008 the Pfeils added a major addition to their property – a renewable energy wind turbine system.

“We’re trying to make the smallest carbon footprint possible,” David says.

The turbine creates enough

electricity to power a large portion of the electrical needs of the Inn at Hickory Run. Along with using a wind turbine to generate energy for the inn, the Pfeils have made an impressive amount of technological upgrades to keep their carbon footprint small. 




